Requirements:

Education:

- *Professional qualification according to current legislation (advantage, not mandatory / beneficial).*

Professional experience and expertise:

- *Practical experience in nutritional interventions and patient education.*
- *Experience in developing educational materials and delivering teaching/training.*
- *Ability to analyse scientific studies and translate evidence into practice.*
- *Experience with research methods (Focus Groups, data collection, analysis).*
- *Familiarity with apps for dietary tracking and monitoring health parameters.*

Publications:

- *At least two professional publications in indexed journals listed in Web of Science or Scopus, published as first author or co-author, focused on metabolic syndrome or diabetes, or a chapter in a monograph addressing diabetes, telemedicine, and eHealth.*

Personal and soft skills:

- *Excellent communication and presentation skills.*
- *Ability to work independently and as part of a team.*
- *Creativity and an innovative approach to designing educational programmes.*
- *Analytical thinking and the ability to formulate practical recommendations.*

Language skills:

- *Czech – native speaker level.*
- *English – sufficient level to work with professional/academic literature.*

The application must include:

- *proof of education*
- *professional CV with details of previous practice*
- *valid criminal record extract*
